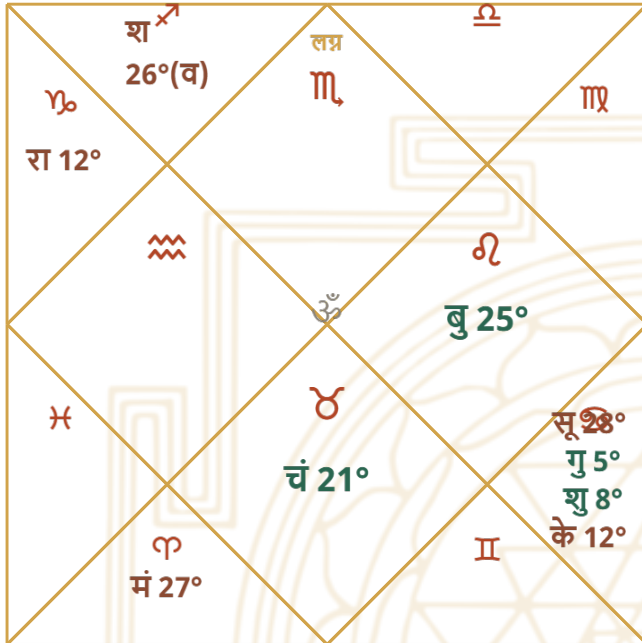

House 12 (Vyaya (Losses)) falls in Libra, ruled by Venus (Shukra), who is placed in House 9. No planets are placed directly in this house. Aspected (drishti) by: Mars (Mangala). This house governs loss, spirituality, and foreign connections.
